The Grand Fleet had a total of 32 Dreadnought and Super-Dreadnought battleships available for use by the time of Jutland. Of these, 28 took part, organized into four Battle Squadrons. [4] The 24 vessels of 2nd, 4th and 1st Battle Squadrons formed the main body of Fleet, and are listed below order from van to rear following their deployment to engage the German fleet, 6:30pm 31 May 1916.

The bulk of the Grand Fleet began leaving Scapa Flow at 2230 on 30 May. HMS Iron Duke, Jellicoe's flagship, led the way, followed by the Fourth then the First Battle Squadrons. At the same time Rear Admiral Horace Hood, in his flagship HMS Invincible, steamed out with the Third Battle Cruiser Squadron, supported by the Second Cruiser Squadron. Around them were eleven light cruisers and forty-two destroyers.
