Next, raise or lower the depth of the blades to match the thickness of the wood you are going to use for your project. I'm going to use regular ¾" lumber for this example.

To begin making your box joint jig, you'll need to determine what width you'll want each of the fingers of the joint to be. For instance, if you want to make your fingers a half inch wide, start by ripping a strip of stock 1/2-inch by 1/2-inch by at least 4 inches long.

Make Perfect Box Joints With a Table Saw Jig

The secret is a built-in system that allows you to adjust both the size and spacing of the pins and slots that make up a box joint in extremely fine increments. By simply turning a knob, you can set the jig to cut slots that range in size from a width of 1/4" to 13/16". A second knob changes the spacing of the pins and slots.

A jig is needed to easily cut 1/2" "fingers" and equally sized spaces in the end of a board. Using this tool will make those cuts clean and efficient. At its simplest, a box joint jig is an auxiliary fence with an indexing key that you attach to your miter gauge. My version adds the stability of a sled and a sliding fence to make adjusting the fit easier.

For reasons of design and proportion, you typically make the individual "fingers" in box joints as wide as the thickness of the workpieces. In this article, we'll make a jig for cutting 1/4" wide fingers in 1/4 "-thick stock (see the drawing below for the precise dimensions of the joints). For thicker or thinner stock you adjust the size of the jig's pin and the width and height of the dado cut accordingly.

Plan ahead by milling some extra parts from the same wood or wood of equal hardness. In addition, make all the pieces extra wide by 1/4 in. or so. It's much better to rip your pieces to final width after all the box joints are cut. Then the last finger or notch will be exactly the same size as all the others.
