You must be a Florida resident for at least 730 days before filing the bankruptcy petition. If you weren't living in any one state during the two years before filing for bankruptcy, you'd use the exemptions of the state you lived in for most of the 180 days before the two-year period that immediately preceded your filing.

Filing Chapter 7 Bankruptcy in Florida Chapter 7 Bankruptcy is the legal procedure where the debtor's unsecured debt is discharged after the debtor's non-exempt assets have been liquidated. To file a Chapter 7

bankruptcy in Florida, a person must be a permanent Florida resident or own property in the state.

However, to be eligible to file for Chapter 13 bankruptcy in Florida, you must have regular income for at least 6 months prior to filing for bankruptcy. Regular income can come from any source including a pension or family support obligation.

Florida has three bankruptcy districts, the Northern District, Middle District and Southern District. The Northern District court is in Jacksonville, while the Middle and Southern District courts are in Tampa and Miami, respectively. While you should generally file in the nearest bankruptcy court, this isn't always the case.
