Guidance on choosing methods and processes | Better Evaluation

Mixed Methods. The evaluation of community engagement may need both qualitative and quantitative methods because of the diversity of issues addressed (e.g., population, type of project, and goals). The choice of methods should fit the need for the evaluation, its timeline, and available resources (Holland et al., 2005; Steckler et al., 1992).

Evaluation findings should be used both to make decisions about program implementation and to improve program effectiveness. Many different questions can be part of a program evaluation, depending on how long the program has been in existence, who is asking the question, and why the information is needed.
