### 3 Ways to Cite a White Paper - wikiHow

Chicago style cites white papers differently according to whether the issuing agency is the author or the paper is presented on behalf of a government agency. If the author is a government agency or organization, format the white paper citation this way: Agency/organization name.White paper title. City: Place of publication, date. Example: World Bank.

The following is generally the order in which you will need to reference the various aspects of a white paper. Keep in mind that if any facet is unavailable, you simply move on to the next point: government department, publication year, title, online reference, paper number, place of publication, the publisher and the URL.

### How to Cite White Papers by a Professional Editor | Jeff ...

Open the white paper and find the first footnote you want to check. Open the PDF that starts with the same footnote number. Search for the exact text or fact given in the white paper and confirm that it's on the page given in the footnote. Read both the source document and the reference to make sure they're exact.

### How to Collect and Check Sources for Your White Paper ...

At the end of your paper (aka bibliography or reference list): a comprehensive list of citations of all the sources you cited in your paper The Details: Your bibliography should appear at the end of your paper in the order you use citations in your paper (eg: in-text citation 1 = reference 1 in your bibliography), not by author last name like in other citation styles such as APA.

### AMA Citation Style for Papers, Projects, and Presentations ...

Use a parenthetical citation in the body of your paper. When you write a statement that comes from the research paper, include the last names of the authors along with the year the paper was published or written. For example: " (Kringle & Frost, 2012)."
