Children are generally referred to as a vulnerable population with respect to their health because of their relative inability to advocate for their own interests and to protect themselves from harm. The World Health Organization identifies children as being particularly vulnerable to poor health outcomes, especially in the case of natural disasters or other calamities 1 .

We call the people in this group health vulnerable. Those Who Are Vulnerable to Exposure. People, often racial or ethnic minorities and immigrants, have a high risk of exposure if, for example, they live in dense neighborhoods, crowded dwellings, or congregate facilities (such as long-term care facilities and prisons).
