During flood (June–September) the river provides less than 30 percent of the main Nile flow at Khartoum because the force of the floodwaters of the Blue Nile holds back the White Nile, turning it into a lake. At low water (April–May) the White Nile's flow is uninhibited, and its contribution is more than 80 percent of total volume.
