How to Write SMART Learning Objectives. If it's good for learning objectives to be SMART, it helps to

know what the letters in SMART stand for. So here it goes. Specific: Use clear, direct language to tell the learner exactly what he or she should learn and what he or she should be able to do after the training.

## **How to Write SMART Learning Objectives | Convergence Training**

Learning objectives can include 3 components: performance, conditions, and criteria.

Performance All SMART learning objectives contain a performance component. The performance statement describes what the learner will know or be able to do in specific, measurable terms. The statement should contain an action verb.

## **Developing Effective Learning Objectives | Faculty ...**

When writing objectives, follow these 3 steps: Step 1. Learning objectives begin with the phrase: "At the conclusion of this activity, participants will be able to...". Step 2. Connect step one with an action verb which communicates the performance by the learner.

Learning objectives usually focus on a single one of these areas. And when writing learning objectives, you should focus on action verbs related to these areas. For example, a knowledge learning objective may include words like these:

The key to writing learning objectives is to make them SMART: Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant, and Timely. Your assessment will tell you whether your objective was specific and measurable enough, while the lesson context dictates the objective's attainability, relevance, and timeliness.

## **A BRIEF GUIDE TO SETTING SMART OBJECTIVES**

The establishment of all objectives should be created using the Specific, Measurable w/Measurement, Achievable, Relevant, Time-Oriented (S.M.A.R.T.) philosophy. What do we mean by a S.M.A.R.T. objective? S.M.A.R.T. is an acronym that is used to guide the development of measurable goals.

## **S.M.A.R.T. Objectives - Wayne LEADS - Wayne State University**

Steps towards writing effective learning objectives: Make sure there is one measurable verb in each objective. Each objective needs one verb. Either a student can master the objective, or they fail to master it. If an objective has two verbs (say, define and apply), what happens if a student can define, but not apply? Are they demonstrating mastery?

## **Using Bloom's Taxonomy to Write Effective Learning Objectives**

The learning objective should be something that you can measure by doing specific activities within

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a definite time frame. Use the SMARTframework when you are writing your learning objective so that it is Specific, Measureable, Achievable, Realistic and has a Timeframe.

## **Writing Learning Objectives for Nursing**

Learning objectives should break down the task and focus on specific cognitive processes. Many activities that faculty believe require a single skill (for example, writing or problem solving) actually involve a synthesis of many component skills.
